The Idea

AI will not only transform *elevators* themselves.

It will also transform how the industry *understands* and *engages with* regulation.

THE REGULATORY INFORMATION CHALLENGE

Regulation has never moved this *fast*, or come from so *many places*.

01

Volume

27 member states, the Commission, Parliament and Council, CEN and CENELEC, national regulators and the trade press all publish in parallel. No team can read it all.

02

Pace

Consultation windows are short. Once a position is set in a delegated act or harmonised standard, the room for influence narrows quickly.

03

Fragmentation

Relevant signals are scattered across institutions, languages and document types – from technical annexes to ministerial statements.

THE ROLE OF AI IN REGULATORY INTELLIGENCE

AI is a tool for *structure* — for finding the few things that matter inside an ocean of text.

01

Comprehensive coverage

Continuously read every relevant institution, member state, standards body and source — without anyone on the team having to remember to check.

02

Signal extraction

Separate what is noise from what is consequential — for your sector, your members, your specific files. Surface the few items worth a human decision.

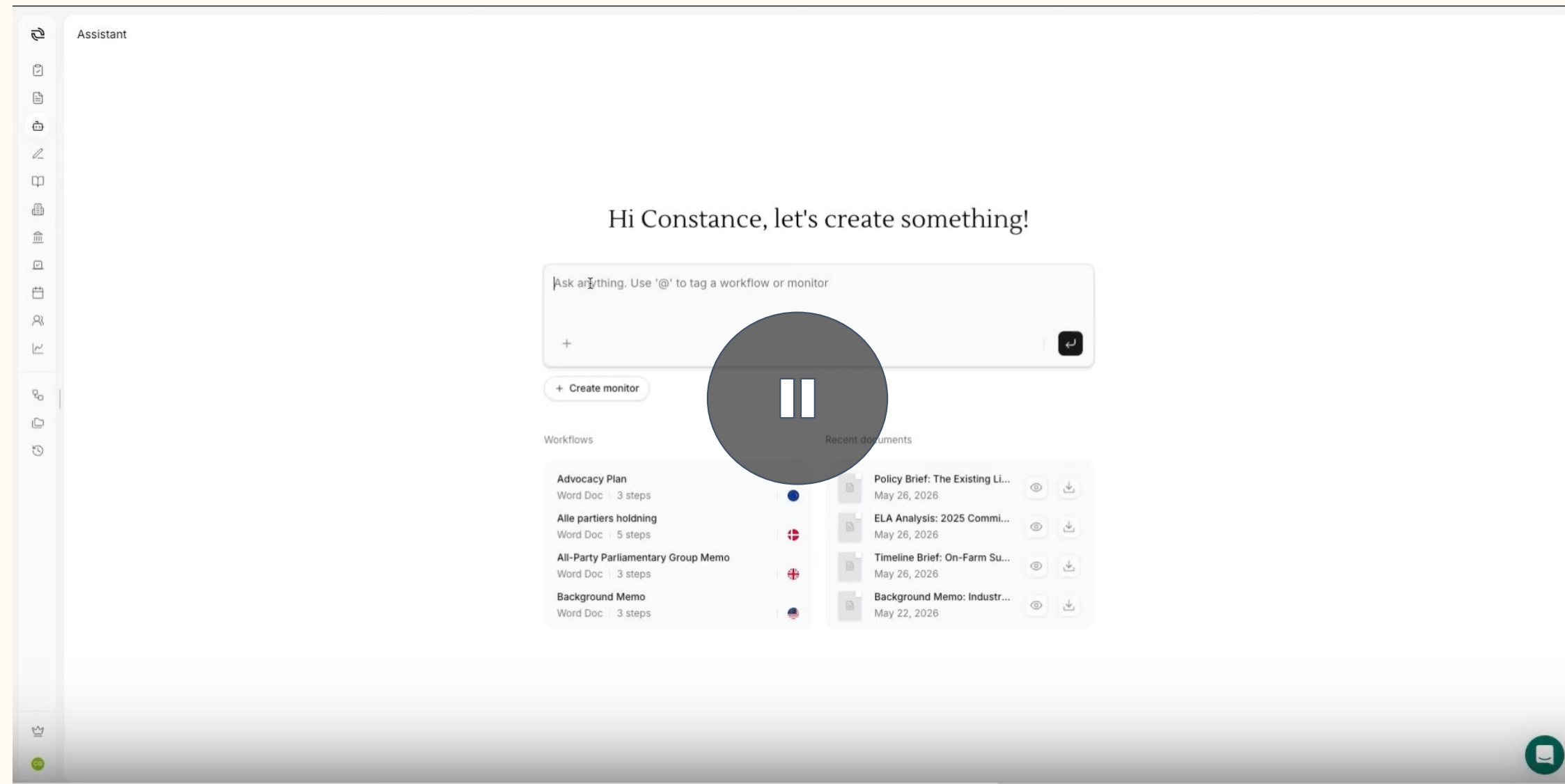
03

Speed to insight

Move from publication to briefing in minutes instead of days, so experts spend their time deciding and engaging, not reading.
